## Stockton University – Center for Academic Advising PERMISSION TO TAKE COURSES AT ANOTHER INSTITUTION

Stockton University authorizes permission for this student to enroll in certain designated courses at another institution under the following conditions:

- 1. A maximum of 64 credits will be accepted from two-year institutions.
- 2. Students who have transferred 96 credits will not be allowed to transfer any other coursework.
- 3. Students must complete 32 of their final 48 credits at Stockton.
- 4. Students must earn a grade of "C" or better to transfer the course to Stockton.
- 5. Permission will not be granted to repeat courses for which a **grade lower than "C"** has already been received at Stockton.
- 6. Students must be in "Good Academic Standing" (above a 2.0 cumulative GPA) to take a course at another institution.
- 7. It is <u>the student's responsibility</u> to have an official transcript sent to the Office of Student Records after completion of the course.
