Financial Aid & Scholarships

FIRST-YEAR (FRESHMAN)

First-year merit scholarships are based on both academic and extracurricular achievement, including:

- Official high school transcript**
- Work experience
- School clubs/organizations
- Volunteerism/community engagement
- Family responsibilities

Test scores (SAT/ACT) and class rank will not be used to determine scholarship eligibility.

TRANSFER

Our ***Excellence in Academics Award*** is for new transfer students with at least 24 transferable college credits.

GPA 3.4 – 3.74 ^: \$1,000/year

GPA 3.75 – 3.99 ^: \$2,000/year

GPA 4.0 ^: \$3,000/year
