In June 2013, Governor Christie established the NJ Alzheimer's Disease Study Commission to develop a comprehensive state plan to address the Alzheimer's epidemic in New Jersey.

The Commission is charged with recommending appropriate courses of action to help families identify & access proper care and support services, to raising awareness about one of our country's most significant health epidemics, to facilitating the continued development of integrated and responsive community based services and to easing the burden of the disease on persons with Alzheimer's disease (AD) and their family members and caregivers through expanded support.
