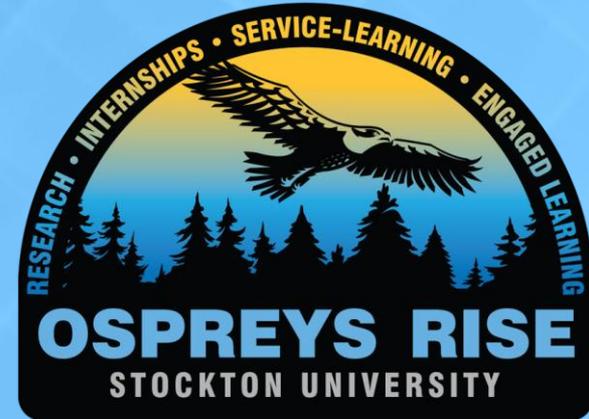

- Qualifying Criteria for Research, Internships, Service Learning, Experiential Learning
- Fall 2023 faculty will review courses for high-impact practices
- Courses will be coded into Banner to help students identify courses that have high-impact practices in them
- Website launch Fall 2023



Live, Work, Learn

442 program eligible (519 applied)

- 245 secured employment
 - +60% from 2022
 - 49 returning students
- 211 completed the program
 - 14% melt (34 withdrawn/removed)
 - 10 did not pass GSS course
 - 17 withdrew from the program
 - 7 terminated from job

Mental Health Grant

- Grant will provide additional student support for mental health for students
- \$22,000 is allocated for faculty and staff development
- Grant funds for nine workshops for faculty and staff to better equip them to support students and faculty/staff mental well-being
- The survey will be distributed in early Spring 2024
- Fall 2024 Workshop launch

- Schools and programs will finalize school and program standards early this fall
 - Should include diversity, equity, inclusion and belonging
 - Must include NTTP standards for advancement
