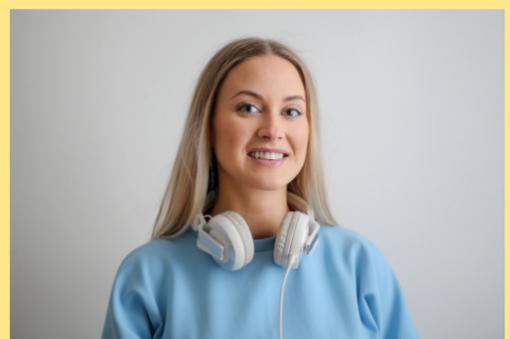
## TEACHING WITH ZOOM

### ADJUSTING YOUR VIDEO IMAGE

#### YOU

Make sure your face and at least a quarter of your upper torso shows on your webcam

#### YOUR ZOOM IMAGE



#### ROOM BRIGHTNESS



#### LIGHTING

Natural or artificial lighting should be directed towards your face. Avoid seating in front of an open window or bright light

#### BACKGROUND

Your background should be uncluttered. Consider using Zoom **Virtual Backgrounds** to add a visual theme

#### NEAT BACKDROP



#### EYES ON AUDIENCE



#### YOUR FOCUS

Look at the camera during your presentation. It gives the sense of direct eye contact and increases visual engagement.
