

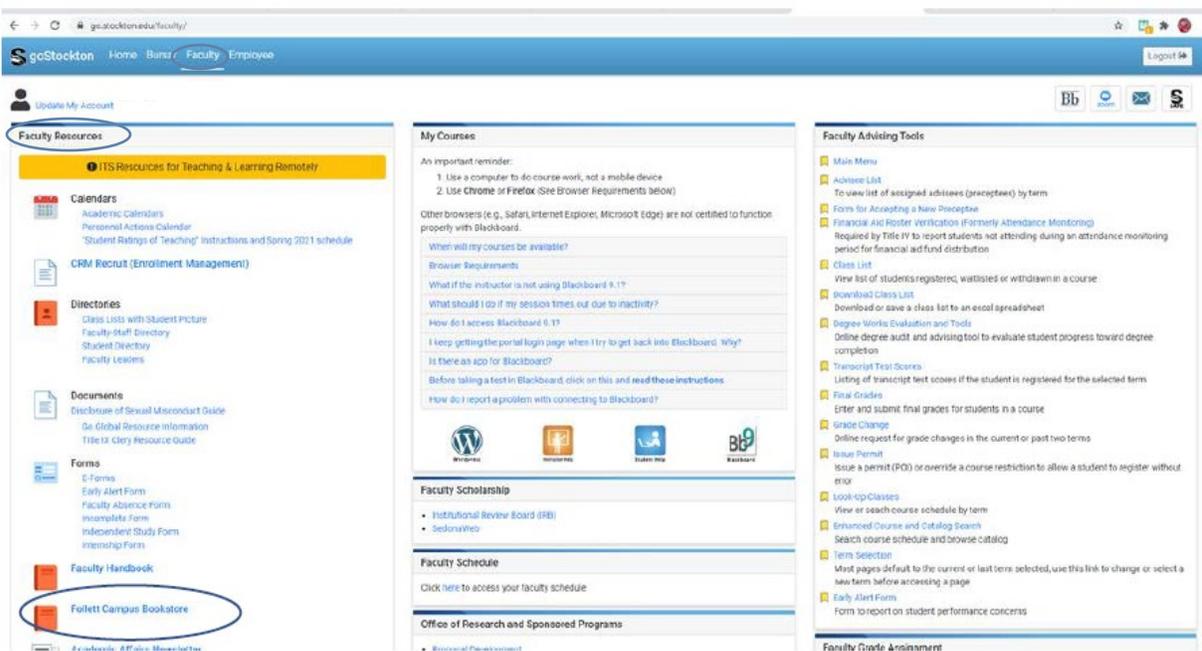
Textbook Adoption Guidelines

- Summer Semester – March 15th

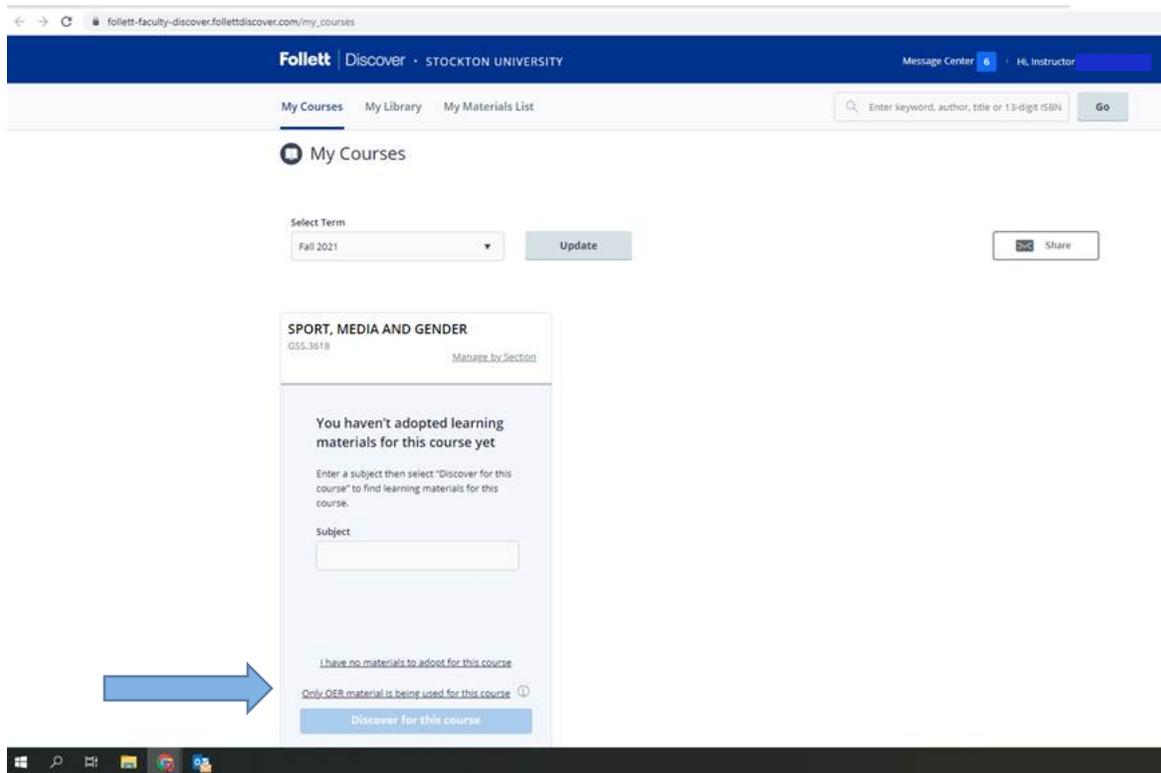
How to adopt course materials through Follett Discover:

- Log into the **Go Portal** with your Stockton credentials.
- Click the **Faculty** tab at the top.
- Under “**Faculty Resources,**” click “**Follett Campus Bookstore.**”
