A grade of "C" or better is required in all content courses and a "B-" or better in professional education courses. "The student is responsible for ensuring that all graduation requirements are met" (Bulletin). Consult with your preceptors in LANG & EDUC on a regular basis. Note: If a student wishes to switch out of the French education concentration, additional courses will be required to complete a BA in LCST.
