- 2. Writing requirement (Sowers): Academic Policy Committee agrees with dropping the JWT. Concern for equity for transfer students. Some FASC members opposed the dropping of the JWT, but all agreed that the discussion should move to the entire FA. MS-FAILED (Colby, Fink) send Connor's request to the faculty with cover letter from us presenting arguments on each side (about 4-9). MSP (Sowers, Trail?) no cover letter (unanimous). For FA on 19 Oct.
- 1. "C" requirement (Sowers): Academic Policy Committee has a draft policy statement (distributed) that would prevent Programs from requiring grades higher than C, but without actually saying so. Logical flaws in the policy proposal were noted, but there was consensus that the discussion should move ahead to the entire FA on 16 Nov.
- 3. Ingulli proposal (Fink): Administration and Finance Committee recommends (a) that MWF schedules be shifted to TRF, in line with Ingulli's recommendation, and (b) the 4:30 meeting module be shifted to 12:30-2pm, which would require that morning classes start at 8:15. Problems for faculty teaching lab, field and studio courses were noted. Consensus for FA consideration on 16 Nov.
- 4. Peace/Conflict Resolution Certificate Proposal: agreement that Charlie should discuss this with Russ.
