

GOOD-STANDING

In order for a chapter to be in good standing with the University, the following requirements must be met:

- I. **Annual Report.** Each chapter must submit documentation for review as directed by the Office of Student Development. Documentation that must be submitted annually includes but is not limited to *Philanthropic Funds Donated, Service Hours Completed, and Programs Hosted*.
- II. **Forms.** Each chapter must submit all required forms as directed by the Office of Student Development.
- III. **GPA.** Each chapter achieves at least a 2.8 overall GPA. Each new member class achieves at least a 2.8 GPA.
- IV. **Insurance.** Each chapter is required to carry insurance coverage as deemed necessary by the Stockton University Office of General Counsel. A current Certificate of Insurance must be stored on OspreyHub. All chapters are required to name "Stockton University" as an additional insured and the certificate must state that the insurance coverage is primary over other collectible insurance.
- V. **Membership Total.** All recognized fraternities and sororities must have at least five (5) fully enrolled undergraduate members on the roster at all times.
- VI. **Membership Updates:** Each chapter is required to provide an updated roster to the Office of Student Development each semester as directed.
- VII. **Programs (University/Council):** Each chapter is required to participate in all workshops, seminars and programs sponsored by the Office of Student Development and the governing councils.
- VIII. **University Rules & Policies:** Each chapter and its members must comply with all University policies, regulations, and procedures as they apply to recognized fraternities and sororities.
