Application for I-20

In order for Stockton University to issue a Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant F-1 Student Status (Form I-20), the applicant and sponsor(s) must read and follow the instructions below accurately. Stockton University is required by the Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) to collect evidence that the applicant will have sufficient funds while studying in the US.

Please submit the Application for I-20 and provide the required financial support documents:

- Application for I-20
- Sponsor's Affidavit of Support
 - Financial support documents: bank statements
 - Proof of income/employment
- Copy of passport biographical page
- Sponsor's Affidavit for Room and Board (if applicable)

If you are already in the U.S with a valid F-1 visa, please also provide the following:

- All previous I-20 forms
- Copy of your most recent US visa
- I-94 form, visit <https://i94.cbp.dhs.gov/> and print it online OPT
- Employment Authorization Document I-765 (if applicable)
- Change of Status Approval (if applicable)

NOTE:

- We do encourage you to complete this application with your Admission Application to process your I-20 request sooner.
- Upon receiving the I-20, please visit <https://www.ice.gov/sevis/i901> to pay the **I-901 SEVIS fee**. Each applicant is required to pay this fee to be registered.
- You must also complete the **Immunization & Health Records form**.
- Sponsors who fail to maintain their financial support might cause the student to drop out of school. Because Federal regulations limit the circumstances under which international students may work. International students should not expect to cover their cost of attendance through employment while studying in the U.S.
- Additional documentation may be required at the discretion of the Office of Admissions, Graduate Studies or Global Engagement.
- Keep a copy of all documents prior to submitting to Stockton University.
