- You must also complete the Immunization & Health Records form.
- Sponsors who fail to maintain their financial support might cause the student to drop out of school. Because Federal regulations limit the circumstances under which international students may work. International students should not expect to cover their cost of attendance through employment while studying in the U.S.
- Additional documentation may be required at the discretion of the Office of Global Engagement, or Office of Admissions.
- Keep a copy of all documents before submitting to Stockton University.
