INTERNAL TRANSFER OPPORTUNITY

Junior or Senior level BSHS students who are preparing for application to Physician Assistant Programs may be eligible to fill a limited number of seats in the BSHS/MSPA Dual-degree Physician Assistant Program through Stockton University and Thomas Jefferson University, as internal transfer students.

Interested students must have all MSPA application pre-requisites completed and must complete their BSHS degree by May 2022. This will be in preparation for a Summer/Fall 2022 admission to the MSPA Program at Thomas Jefferson University – NJ Campus.

Application materials should be submitted in electronic form to the assigned private Google Folder (contact Dr. Sowers for access to a folder). Letters of recommendation may be submitted separately by email. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed by the committee.

All applicants must be eligible to apply to CASPA between April – October 2021, for a MSPA program starting in Summer/Fall 2022.

Students accepted for internal transfer to this program will agree to apply only to the Jefferson University – NJ Campus option on CASPA. If accepted as an internal transfer, you will be guaranteed a seat in the Jefferson NJ Campus program. Please do not apply as an internal transfer if this is not your first-choice program, or if you will opt to attend a different program than the Thomas Jefferson University NJ Campus. Being eligible to apply as an internal transfer is not a guarantee of admission to the program. Acceptance as an internal transfer is dependent on the number of available seats and a committee decision about your application.

- Must meet Stockton University graduation requirements by May 2022
- BSHS major
- Minimum GPA of 3.25 (or higher) in core courses
- Minimum GPA of 3.25 (or higher) overall
- C or above in all core or pre-requisite courses (listed below)
- Minimum of 100 direct patient contact hours (by application deadline)

Additional Application Requirements:

- Resume with evidence of leadership and service
- Two letters of recommendation
 - o One from an academic source (professor)
 - o One from a professional source (through patient contact hours)
- Must complete a total of 200 direct patient contact hours prior to September 1, 2021
- Must complete EMT or CNA certification prior to September 1, 2021
- Video question (not to exceed 5 minutes)
