FOUR WINTERS is an award-winning film using eyewitness testimonies of Holocaust survivors who were partisans interwoven with archival footage. FOUR WINTERS tells the story of the power of Jewish resistance in Nazi-occupied Europe by the Jewish partisans who escaped ghettos and concentration camps and became fighters in the woods. Many of these partisans were young adults who fought against the Nazi Regime in organized resistance during WWII. The film running time is 1:40 minutes.

I escaped the Vilna ghetto from Rudnicka Street through a sewer line. We had to crawl out from the sewers; we exited in dark places back onto the Vilna streets. We were on our way to the partisans walking only at night for days. While organizing with the partisans, we met some Jews coming from the Vilna ghetto. They explained the Nazis had liquidated the ghetto on September 23, 1943. I later learned most were murdered and buried at Ponary. Sam Schoffer - Born 1923 in Vilna, which was then Poland – Lived in Margate, NJ and died 2014
