

Former Trump White House Counsel Don McGahn to Speak at Stockton Jan. 23

Galloway, N.J. – The William J. Hughes Center for Public Policy at Stockton University will host a conversation with former White House Counsel Don McGahn at 4 p.m. Jan. 23 at the Stockton University Performing Arts Center.

McGahn, an Atlantic County native, worked as chief counsel for the National Republican Congressional Committee and served on the Federal Election Commission. He also served as President Donald Trump’s presidential campaign counsel, general counsel of the Presidential Transition Team, and White House Counsel. As White House Counsel he managed the judicial selection process, including the nominations of two Supreme Court Justices, and coordinated President Trump’s deregulation efforts.
