

Stockton University has partnered with AtlantiCare to assist employees seeking COVID testing, as follows:

- Any employee who was exposed to COVID-19 at the workplace should contact the Office of Human Resources (609-626-5503) for guidance and to schedule an appointment with AtlantiCare Occupational Health. The AtlantiCare provider will refer you for testing. Stockton University will cover the cost of the telemedicine visit and testing in these instances.
- Symptomatic or asymptomatic employees who had non-work related close contact (i.e., within 6 feet for a total of 15 minutes over a 24 hour period while the infected person was infectious) with a confirmed COVID positive individual can contact AtlantiCare at 1-888-285-2684.
 - AtlantiCare will first schedule a telemedicine visit with one of their providers. The employee will then be referred for testing. Testing is performed at one of AtlantiCare's locations.
 - Insured employees should provide their health insurance information during the telemedicine visit.
 - Uninsured employees will have their telemedicine visit and testing costs covered by Stockton University. Uninsured employees should notify AtlantiCare during their telemedicine visit that:
 - You are a Stockton employee
 - You do not currently have health insurance
- There are no "walk ins" for tests under this arrangement with AtlantiCare. You must have a telemedicine visit in order to be referred for testing.

Employees who do not have any COVID symptoms and were not in close contact with a COVID positive individual can explore alternate testing options that include:

- Contacting your primary care physician to discuss testing
- Atlantic County Department of Human Services in Northfield offers free COVID testing for Atlantic County residents only. Visit their [website](#) to schedule an appointment
