SUMMARY STATEMENTS

Spring 2011 Enrollment

New Students:

Undergraduate: The 597 new undergraduates who registered this semester represent 12 first-time freshmen, 531 transfer students, and 54 readmitted students.

Graduate: The graduate program enrolled 117 new students.

Doctoral Program in Physical Therapy:

There are currently 53 students enrolled in the DPT program and 46 students enrolled in the transitional DPT program.

Headcount & FTE:

Total Population: There are 7515 students registered, generating 6763 FTE.

Undergraduate: The College enrolled 6772 students this semester generating 6335 FTE.

Graduate (including post baccalaureate): There are 743 students enrolled this semester with a corresponding FTE of 428.

Matriculated vs. Non-Matriculated Students: The percentage of matriculated undergraduate students increased slightly to 99% while the percentage of matriculated graduate students increased from 90% to 91%.

Credit Load: Average undergraduate credit load increased to 15.0 credits per student. Graduate students' average credit load also remained steady at 6.9 credits per student.

AY 10-11 Annualized Headcount & FTE**

Total Population: The combined annualized headcount is 7697, which is a 4% increase from last year's number. Annualized FTE increased by 4%

Undergraduate: The AY10-11 annualized headcount for undergraduate students is 6917 an increase of 3% from the AY09-10 annualized headcount. The corresponding FTE is 6453; a 4% increase over last year's figure of 6183.

Graduate: (including post baccalaureate): The graduate annualized headcount is 780, which is an 8% increase, and 436 FTE, a 6% increase.
