

**SUMMARY STATEMENTS**

**Spring 2012 Enrollment**

**New Students:**

Undergraduate: The 481 new undergraduates who registered this semester represent 13 first-time freshmen, 455 transfer students, and 13 readmitted\*\* students.

Graduate: The graduate program enrolled 111 new students.

**Doctoral Program in Physical Therapy:**

There are currently 49 students enrolled in the DPT program and 44 students enrolled in the transitional DPT program.

**Headcount & FTE:**

Total Population: There are 7809 students registered, generating 7126 FTE.

Undergraduate: The College enrolled 7003 students this semester generating 6660 FTE.

Graduate (including post baccalaureate): There are 806 students enrolled this semester with a corresponding FTE of 466.

**Matriculated vs. Non-Matriculated Students**: The percentage of matriculated undergraduate students remained steady at 99% while the percentage of matriculated graduate students decreased from 91% to 88%.

**Credit Load**: Average undergraduate credit load increased to 15.2 credits per student. Graduate students' average credit load also remained steady at 6.9 credits per student.

**AY 11-12 Annualized Headcount & FTE<sup>†</sup>**

**Total Population**: The combined annualized headcount is 7959, which is a 4% increase from last year's number. Annualized FTE increased by 5%

**Undergraduate**: The AY11-12 annualized headcount for undergraduate students is 7122; an increase of 3% from the AY10-11 annualized headcount. The corresponding FTE is 6773; a 5% increase over last year's figure of 6453.

**Graduate**: (including post baccalaureate): The graduate annualized headcount is 837, which is a 7% increase, and 475 FTE, an 8% increase.

\*\*Beginning with Spring 2012, the readmission process for former Stockton students who had not attended another institution, has been streamlined to eliminate a Stockton application. These students completed a readmission form through the Registrar's Office and they are reflected in the continuing student numbers.
