Galloway, NJ – Stockton University's School of Arts & Humanities will host an artist lecture by Sophie Knee, a printmaker and painter, on **Wednesday, March 23 from 11:20 a.m. - 2 p.m.** on the main Galloway campus in room C-134. Following the lecture, Knee will host an informal presentation at the printmaking studio in the Arts & Sciences building in room 140 from 2:30 – 4:30 p.m.

Knee creates monotypes, prints made by applying ink to a surface then transferring the ink to paper with pressure.

"Monotypes are not reproductions: each one exists as a unique object and none are repeatable," Knee said. "The successful print exists as a transaction between artist and art viewer in which both are complicit. Both give, but both also take."
