Galloway Township, NJ- The Sara and Sam Schoffer Holocaust Resource Center of The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey is sponsoring a workshop titled Echoes and Reflections designed for middle, high school, and college educators on Monday, March 8, from 9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Professional development hours (PDH) are available for New Jersey educators. The workshop is free and will be offered in The Sara and Schoffer Holocaust Resource Center located on the second floor of Stockton's Library.

The workshop presenter will be Shulamit Imber, Pedagogical Director of Yad Vashem International School for Holocaust Studies. Yad Vashem, the Anti-Defamation League, and the USC Shoah Foundation Institute for Visual Studies developed Echoes and Reflections, a multimedia curriculum for the classroom. The curriculum encourages classroom discussions and knowledge relevant to contemporary issues of prejudice. Lessons focus on prejudice reduction, cultural diversity, character education, the Holocaust and other genocides, and discrimination. Curriculum and video testimonies will be given free of charge to each educator participant.
