Internationally renowned #1 New York Times best-selling author of *Talking to Heaven*, *Reaching to Heaven, Healing Grief, Heaven and Earth, Looking Beyond, Meditations, Ghosts Among Us, Unfinished Business and Growing Up In Heaven*, James is considered a pioneer in the mediumship movement throughout the world. He has been recognized as one of the most accurate spiritual mediums working today. His messages have brought solace, peace and spiritual insights, changing millions view of both life and death. He has received many awards for dedicating himself to changing the consciousness of the planet.

As a trailblazer, Van Praagh introduced the world to mediumship when he was the first medium on the NBC daytime television show "The Other Side" in 1994. Since then, he has appeared on numerous national radio and television shows, including "Oprah," "Larry King Live," "Dr. Phil," A & E's "Biography," "Nightline," "Unsolved Mysteries," "The View," "The Joy Behar Show," "The Today Show," "Dr. Drew's Life Changers."
