Poritz, will deliver the keynote address at The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey's Constitution Day celebration on **Tuesday, September 21, 2010, at 6:00 p.m.** Due to a large number of students, faculty and staff expected to attend the lecture, the event has been moved to the Performing Arts Center (PAC), which is located on the College's main Galloway Township campus.

In celebration of the 90th anniversary of women's suffrage, Justice Poritz's lecture will focus on the development of women's legal rights in New Jersey.

The nation's Founding Fathers signed the U.S. Constitution on September 17, 1787. In 2004, a law was passed to establish Constitution Day, an American federal observance of the formation and signing of the Constitution.
