Tom Sandor, a local artist and SCOSA volunteer, is the instructor for the classes held in the Community Meeting Room at the Atlantic County Library System's Egg Harbor Township branch at 1 Swift Ave.

Guided by Sandor's experience and expertise, participants will learn to draw what they see, at their own pace, developing powers of observation and defining individual style. With emphasis on self-discovery and skill development, the class will focus on building and refining basic skills, exploring a broad range of drawing materials and sharing ideas and techniques. Participants must purchase and bring their own materials. No experience is necessary, but those who have work samples are encouraged to bring them to the class.
