Galloway, NJ - Stockton University's Master of Social Work (MSW) degree program has been named one of the 50 Most Affordable Accredited MSW Programs in the East by The Best Social Work Programs.

Stockton's MSW Program is designed to prepare social workers for advanced-level social work practice with diverse individuals, families, and communities. An important component of the program is an in-depth internship experience, where students have an opportunity to apply their classroom learning to real-life situations. Working in social agencies under the supervision of experienced social work field instructors, last year students provided nearly 40,000 hours of service to individuals, families, and communities in Atlantic and surrounding counties.

The Best Social Work Programs, an online business launched in 2012 to provide free resources to anyone interested in social work degrees and careers, said, "Stockton University's School of Social and Behavioral Sciences offers an affordable MSW degree program designed to equip and educate professional social workers."

Using NCES College Navigator, the raters selected schools offering an MSW in New England, Mid-Atlantic, and southeastern states. The Best Social Work Programs compiled the list of accredited programs and ranked them based on affordability. Tuition data was gathered from the NCES College Navigator database. (The Best Social Work Programs assumed that students would take 9 credits a term, whereas students enrolled in most social work programs take approximately 15 credits a term.)

Graduates of Stockton's MSW programs have a record of successful career outcomes. Graduates are employed throughout the region in the fields of health, behavioral health, family services, substance abuse, child welfare, school social work and gerontology.
