Galloway Township, NJ – In an effort to raise awareness of the voting process and the Building Our Future higher education bond referendum, Stockton’s Student Senate and the Stockton Entertainment Team are presenting a special event, “Burritos, Ballots and the Bond”, Tuesday October 23, 2012 from 6 to 9 p.m. at the Campus Center Coffee House.

“We are planning a fun event with a serious message about supporting a good voter turnout and to engage and inform students as to why their vote is of critical importance,” said Student Senate President A.J. Vervoot, a senior political science major from Galloway.
