Galloway Township, NJ – Senate and Assembly candidates in New Jersey's Legislative District 9 will face off in debates hosted by The William J. Hughes Center for Public Policy at The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey.

The debates, co-sponsored by the Press of Atlantic City, are between Senator Chris Connors (R) and Dorothy Ryan (D), and Assemblywoman DiAnne Gove (R), Assemblyman Brian Rumpf (R) and Carla Kearney (D) and Bradley Billhimer (D), will take place Wednesday evening, October 19 in the Campus Center Theatre at the Galloway campus.

The Senate Debate starts at 6 p.m. and the Assembly Debate will take place at approximately 7 p.m. at the conclusion of the Senate Debate. Free parking is available in the parking lots adjacent to the Campus Center.
