Galloway Township, NJ- The Stockton Center on Successful Aging (SCOSA) will present a "Take Better Pictures, Critique" Workshop led by Judith Heyman on Wednesday, October 17, 2012 from 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm at the Noyes Museum of Art, 733 Lily Lake Road, Oceanville, Galloway Township, NJ.

Judith Heyman will take participants beyond basic concepts of composing a "good shot". She will discuss the competition judging process and what the judges look for. She will critique photographs, cover a variety of locations where to exhibit photography and discuss how to approach business owners about displaying photos.

Attendees will learn about photo clubs and the Photographic Society of America. Participants are encouraged to bring their cameras and some recent photos to get tips on how to improve. Advance registration is required before October 10, 2012 – limited capacity.
