POLICY:

Stockton operates on a "4-4" semester calendar. Each of the two semesters is preceded by a preceptorial term (preterm) which includes a time for new student orientation, advising, and registration. The fall term normally begins just after Labor Day and ends before Christmas. The spring term normally begins on the day following the Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday in January and ends in early May. The winter break comes between the fall and spring terms; the spring break occurs midway in the spring term. The summer terms runs from mid-May to mid-August on varying schedules.
