

<u>PURPOSE</u>: The Office of Research and Sponsored Programs invites you to participate in the 19th Annual Day of Scholarship. Presenters will share their scholarly work and provide listeners with opportunities to engage in Stockton's academic community.

ELIGIBILITY: All Stockton staff and faculty members are invited to submit project ideas **for one oral presentation only**. Projects may be works-in-progress, substantially developed, or completed. A limited number of slots are available. Those encouraged to apply include:

- Recent recipients of internal award programs.
- Faculty-sponsored advanced students whose projects are substantially more than a class project.
- Projects in academic disciplines, pedagogy or current issues in higher education.
- Submissions duplicating a past year's presentation topic will be given lower priority.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- **APPLICATION:** Complete **one** Application only, including Panel participants who should submit a joint application. The short summary, which will be used in the Program Guide Book, should briefly describe the project using minimal discipline jargon. The presentation should be developed and written for the general public.
- **APPLICATION REVIEW:** Applications will be reviewed within 10 days from the submission deadline. Applications will be chosen based on content and alignment with 2020 Initiatives and/or disciplines, aiming to include a variety of topics to appeal to an array of audience members.
- **ACCEPTANCE:** Accepted applications will be scheduled in 25-minute oral sessions as well as poster displays. Applicants will receive further format instruction with their acceptance notification.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Presentations will be scheduled in the Campus Center conference rooms as follows:
 - Poster Presentations: 9:00am to 10:00am (posters will remain up for display throughout the event)
 - Oral Presentations: 10:00am to 1:00pm
- Presenters should bring their own laptop/flash drive.
- Faculty may participate as a presenter **at only one presentation**, not including poster sessions.
- In the interest of including as many applicants as possible, double sessions are limited and may not be available.
- Faculty can sponsor several student presenters keeping in line with the eligibility guidelines.
- Student presenters may only present at **one** presentation, not including poster sessions.
- A continental breakfast will be available for presenters and guests during the Poster Presentations in the Main Event Room from 9-10am; beverages and a light snack will be provided at 11am and replenished throughout the event.
