## Call for Proposals - R&PD

The R&PD fund for research and creative work makes available \$195,000 to be awarded for FY15. An additional \$100,000 will again be available to support course releases/overloads but new for FY15 – requests can be for either Fall 2014 or Spring 2015 semesters.

Proposals may request course release/overload and/or funds depending on what the project needs to be successful. Faculty requesting course releases are encouraged to work directly with Program Coordinators, Directors, Deans and/or Assistant Deans to request a schedule that best meets the needs of the project.

We invite proposals which have the potential to lead to significant outside funding, creative work in the arts, pedagogical studies, and publication in any field of learning. Projects aligned with the 2020 themes are welcomed.

Proposals are due by 5:00pm on February 15, 2014. Please submit an electronic/scanned copy of the entire application package to the Grants Office at grants@stockton.edu as well as one original hard copy with signatures to E-226.
