Call for Proposals

Provost Faculty Opportunities Fund

- Support for travel to conferences, student assistant, professional services or supplies related to scholarship in 2020 Initiatives. For event occurring during January 1st – June 30th, 2016.
- An average of \$2,000 per award is available.
- Guidelines are available on the ORSP website and applications are due no later than 5:00pm, December 1, 2015.

Provost Professional Development Award in Faculty Precepting

- Support for research on Stockton's academic advising programs. For projects completed by June 30th, 2016.
- A pot of \$4,000 is available to fund 1 to 4 projects.
- Guidelines are available on the ORSP website and applications are due electronically to grants@stockton.edu no later than 5:00pm, December 1, 2015.

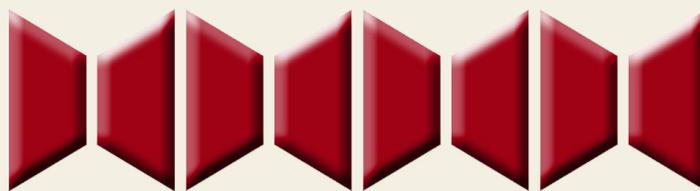

Supports professionals in the social sciences and humanities, including economics, international affairs, government/politics, and philosophy. Although there is no specific deadline, proposals must be submitted at least 120 days before the project is to begin (LOIs requested before proposal). Grants range from \$500 to \$20,000. No grants for capital, building, or endowment funds, operating budgets, continuing support, annual campaigns, seed money, emergency funds, deficit financing, or matching gifts.
