## Small and Large Grants



**Amount:** Individual grants range greatly in amount, from several thousand dollars to several million.  
- Small Grants: \$234,800 or less  
- Large Grants: more than \$234,800  
Grant duration is often up to three years.

**Timeline:** 14 Aug 2020 Inquiry/Grant  
Inquiry/Preliminary Inquiry  
15 Jan 2021 Full Proposal

*The Full Proposal stage for small grants is not governed by any specific calendar. Instead, staff will invite Full Proposals with customized due dates that are influenced by the project's anticipated start date, the internal workload of staff, and budget considerations.*
