Research and Evaluation on Technology-Facilitated Abuse for Criminal Justice Purposes United States Department of Justice (DOJ) Office of Justice Programs (OJP) National Institute of Justice (NIJ)



Deadline: April 8, 2020

Abstract: With this solicitation, NIJ seeks proposals for research projects addressing the use of technologies such as texting, mobile applications, telecommunications networks, and social networking to bully, harass, stalk or intimidate another person, including adolescents. Examples of technology facilitated abuse include cyberstalking, sextortion, non-consensual pornography, doxing, or swatting. NIJ will support scientifically rigorous research projects that will advance understanding of these types of crime, and effective approaches for identifying, preventing, investigating, and prosecuting them. This solicitation supports the U.S. Department of Justice's strategic goals associated with reducing crime, supporting prosecutors, and reducing victimization.
