Review Cycles for Faculty Appointed Under Article XIII-D OR XIII-O Who Subsequently Become Tenure Track Faculty

Thoroughly read the locally-negotiated agreements: <u>Faculty Evaluation Policy (2016)</u> which outlines standards of excellence for faculty performance, and the <u>Faculty Evaluation Procedures (MOA 2015)</u> which outlines procedures for evaluating faculty performance and promotion.

- 1) XIII-D or XIII-O faculty who are appointed to tenure track positions in their **Second Year**:
 - You will receive an initial (1) year contract.
 - Select a Review Advisor (a tenured faculty member selected by you in consultation with your Dean) to help you construct your file. **(Optional)**
 - You will create a Faculty Plan in the Fall of your second year (**Required**) (pg. 27, MOA). Please review the <u>University</u>, <u>School</u>, and <u>Program</u> standards of excellence.
 - In the Spring of year two (2), you will undergo a **Decision "Action" Review** and will prepare a complete Evaluation File the same as other second-year tenure track faculty as set forth in sections II A and II B of the <u>MOA Procedures</u> (**Required**). Please read the summary guide on Second-Fifth Year File Construction for instructions on the preparation of your file.
 - All subsequent reviews will be the same as for other tenure track faculty (years 3-5), except that if you are denied tenure in year five you will be entitled to a Reconsideration Review in year six.
- 2) XIII-D or XIII-O faculty who are appointed to tenure track positions in their **Third Year**:
 - You will receive an initial two (2) year contract.
 - Select a Review Advisor (a tenured faculty member selected by you in consultation with your Dean) to help you construct your file. **(Optional)**
 - You are not required to develop a Faculty Plan but may do so informally as noted above.
 - In the Spring of year three (3), you will undergo a Feedback Review that follows the procedures for a First-Year Feedback review. You will prepare a complete Evaluation File as set forth in sections II A and II B of the MOA Procedures. Please review the University, School, and Program standards of excellence. Please read the summary

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guide on Second-Fifth Year File Construction for instructions on the preparation of your file.

- In the Spring of year four (4), you will undergo a **Decision "Action" Review** and will be recommended for either a two (2) year contract for years five and six with a tenure review in year five or a terminal one-year contract for year five. Please read the summary guide on Second-Fifth Year File Construction for instructions on the preparation of your file.
- The review in year four will be by the PRC and Dean unless either of these levels recommends a terminal one-year contract, in which case the review will extend to the FRC, Provost, and President.
- If you have a tenure review in year five and are not recommended for tenure, you will be entitled to a Reconsideration Review in year six.
- 3) XIII-D or XIII-O faculty who are appointed to tenure track positions in their **Fourth Year**:
 - You will receive an initial two (2) year contract through year six.
 - Select a Review Advisor (a tenured faculty member selected by you in consultation with your Dean) to help you construct your file. **(Optional)**
 - In the Spring of year four (4), you will undergo a Feedback Review that follows the procedures for a First Year Feedback review. You will prepare a complete Evaluation File as set forth in sections II A and II B of the MOA Procedures. Please review the University, School, and Program standards of excellence. Please read the summary guide on Second-Fifth Year File Construction for instructions on the preparation of your file.
 - You will have a tenure review in year five the same as other tenure track faculty. If not recommended for tenure, you will be entitled to a Reconsideration Review in year six.
