Compassionate Teaching

The teacher-student relationship has a powerful impact on student achievement. Variables of faculty **empathy, warmth, and encouragement** were significant factors in positive student performance.

Student Voice Survey (Inside Higher Education and College Pulse) asked over 1,000 students to predict success in Fall 2021.

- Fifty percent of students identified mental health* as a source of concern for finishing coursework and obtaining good grades.
- *Mental Health Issues
 - Anxiety/Stress
 - Depression
 - Loneliness

- Explore the Student Experience (Survey, Discussion, Assignment)
- Emphasize Social Aspects of Learning (Introductions, Conversation, Groups)
- Flexible Assessments & Attendance (with Accountability/Structure)
- Provide Resource Information (available in <u>CTLD Sample Syllabus</u>)
- Encourage Self-Care
