Spring 2009 Enrollment Report* SUMMARY STATEMENTS

Spring 2009 Enrollment

New Students:

Undergraduate: The **558** new undergraduates who registered this semester represent **19** first-time freshmen, **465** transfer students, and **74** readmitted students.

Graduate: The graduate program enrolled **75** new students.

Doctoral Program in Physical Therapy:

There are currently **64** students enrolled in the DPT program and **56** students enrolled in the transitional DPT program.

Headcount & FTE:

Total Population: There are **7039** students registered, generating **6038** FTE.

Undergraduate: The college enrolled **6446** students this semester generating **5720** FTE.

Graduate (including post baccalaureate): There are **593** students enrolled this semester with a corresponding FTE of **318**.

Matriculated vs. Non-Matriculated Students: The percentage of matriculated undergraduate students remained steady at **97%** while the percentage of matriculated graduate students increased from **85%** to **87%**.

Credit Load: Undergraduate credit load increased slightly to **14.2** credits per student. Graduate students' average credit load remained steady at **6.4**.

AY 08-09 Annualized Headcount & FTE**

Total Population: The combined annualized headcount is **7173**, which is a **0.2%** decrease from last year's number. Annualized FTE increased by **1.2%**.

Undergraduate: The AY08-09 annualized headcount for undergraduate students is **6559** a decrease of less than **1%** from the AY07-08 annualized headcount. The corresponding FTE is **5849** an increase of **1%** over last year's figure of 5799.

Graduate (including post baccalaureate): The graduate annualized headcount is **615**, a **6%** increase, and **331** FTE, a **9%** increase.
